AN ACT

To amend chapter 302, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the operation of commercial motor vehicles, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 302, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto
2 one new section, to be known as section 302.785, to read as
3 follows:

302.785. 1. As used in this section, terms shall have
2 the same meanings as ascribed to them in sections 302.700 to
3 302.780.

4 2. No commercial motor vehicle shall operate in this
5 state unless operated or occupied by a natural person
6 holding the proper class of license or applicable
7 endorsements valid for the type of vehicle being operated,
8 or a commercial driver's instruction permit, or a receipt
9 which indicates the driver is qualified to drive a
10 commercial motor vehicle.

11 3. The owner of a commercial motor vehicle operated in
12 violation of this section shall be guilty of a class A
13 misdemeanor. Any owner who provides proof to the court
14 which has jurisdiction over the issued citation by the date
15 the owner must appear in court or pay any fine for such a
16 violation that a natural person present in the commercial
17 motor vehicle held a valid commercial driver's license at
18 the time the citation was issued shall not be guilty of this

19 offense. No court shall suspend the imposition of sentence
20 as to such person nor sentence such person to a fine in lieu
21 of a term of imprisonment, nor shall such person be eligible
22 for parole or probation until he or she has served a minimum
23 of forty-eight consecutive hours of imprisonment, unless as
24 a condition of such parole or probation, such person
25 performs at least ten days involving at least forty hours of
26 community service under the supervision of the court in
27 those jurisdictions which have a recognized program for
28 community service.
