AN ACT

To amend chapter 589, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the offense of unlawful contact with a victim of a sexual offense, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 589, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 589.430, to read as follows:

589.430. 1. A person commits the offense of unlawful contact 2 with a victim of a sexual offense if he or she:

3 (1) Is required to register as a sexual offender under sections
4 589.400 to 589.425; and

5 (2) Knowingly has direct or indirect contact with a victim of the 6 offense for which he or she is required to register as a sexual offender 7 for the purpose of harassing or disturbing the victim.

8 2. The offense of unlawful contact with a victim of a sexual 9 offense is a class C felony until December 31, 2016, and a class D felony 10 beginning January 1, 2017.

3. For purposes of this section, the phrase "harassing or
 disturbing" shall have the same meaning as "harasses" under section
 565.225 until December 31, 2016, and "disturbs" under section 565.225
 beginning January 1, 2017.
