## **AN ACT**

To amend chapter 161, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the distribution of certain federal moneys to elementary and secondary schools, with an emergency clause.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 161, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto

- 2 one new section, to be known as section 161.228, to read as
- 3 follows:
  - 161.228. 1. The department of elementary and
- 2 secondary education shall not distribute to any public
- 3 school district or charter school any grant of funds
- 4 received in whole or in part under the federal Coronavirus
- 5 Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, Pub. L. 116-
- 6 136, or under any other federal statute passed in response
- 7 to COVID-19, for expenses incurred by such school district
- 8 or charter school beginning July 1, 2020, without first
- 9 receiving evidence from the school district or charter
- 10 school that demonstrates at the time of each such
- 11 distribution that, except for good cause shown, such school
- 12 district or charter school:
- 13 (1) Has adopted a policy providing for in-person
- 14 attendance for at least four days of instruction per week;
- 15 **and**
- 16 (2) Has provided in-person attendance for at least
- 17 four days of instruction per week in the period since the

opening date of the school calendar and the date of the proposed distribution of grant funds under this section.

- 2. For purposes of this section, "COVID-19" shall mean any disease, health condition, or threat of harm caused by the severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 or a virus mutating therefrom.
  - 3. For purposes of this section, "good cause" shall include only temporary modifications to a school district's or charter school's in-person attendance policy in response to COVID-19 which authorize the cancellation of school days or remote teaching of student for less than fourteen consecutive days.

Section B. Because immediate action is necessary to 2 coordinate the responses of public and charter schools to 3 the COVID-19 pandemic in a manner that ensures students 4 receive all necessary instruction, section A of this act is 5 deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, welfare, peace, and safety, and is hereby 6 7 declared to be an emergency act within the meaning of the constitution, and section A of this act shall be in full 8 9 force and effect upon its passage and approval.
