AN ACT

To repeal section 488.650, RSMo, relating to a surcharge for petition for expungement.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 488.650, RSMo, is repealed, to read as follows:

2 follows:
3 [488.650. There shall be assessed as costs
4 a surcharge in the amount of two hundred fifty
5 dollars on all petitions for expungement filed
6 under the provisions of section 610.140. The
7 judge may waive the surcharge if the petitioner
8 is found by the judge to be indigent and unable
9 to pay the costs. Such surcharge shall be
10 collected and disbursed by the clerk of the
11 court as provided by sections 488.010 to
488.020. Moneys collected from this surcharge
shall be payable to the general revenue fund.]
