AN ACT

To amend chapter 443, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to deeds of trust.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 443, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 443.323, to read as follows:

- 443.323. 1. For any beneficiary who is not the originating beneficiary on the deed of trust, the beneficiary shall record a summary document regarding the beneficiary's legal interest in the deed of trust that contains the following information in chronological order:
- 5 (1) The full name and address of record of every prior 6 beneficiary on the deed of trust;
- (2) The date, recordation number, or other unique designation of the instrument, and a description of the instrument that conveyed the interest of each beneficiary.
- 2. The summary document prescribed by this section shall be recorded at the same time and place that the notice of trustee's sale is recorded pursuant to section 443.320 and a copy of the summary document shall be attached to any notice of trustee's sale otherwise required to be provided as prescribed by law.
- 3. Failure to properly record the summary document that demonstrates evidence of title for the foreclosing beneficiary as of the date of the trustee's sale as prescribed by this section that result in a voidable sale.
- 4. Any person with an interest in the trust property may file an action to void the trustee's sale for failure to comply with this section and is entitled to an award of attorney fees as well as damages as

22 otherwise provided by law if the person substantially prevails,
