AN ACT

To repeal sections 700.090 and 700.095, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to manufactured housing.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

	Section A. Sections 700.090 and 700.095, RSMo, are
2	repealed and two new sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be
3	known as sections 700.090 and 700.095, to read as follows:
	700.090. 1. Every manufacturer or dealer who sells or
2	offers for sale, on consignment or otherwise, a manufactured
3	home or modular unit from or in the state of Missouri shall
4	register with the commission each place of business at which
5	the manufacturer or dealer sells or offers for sale a
6	manufactured home or modular unit.
7	2. The commission shall issue a certificate of
8	registration to a manufacturer who:
9	(1) Completes and files with the commission an
10	application for registration which contains the following
11	information:
12	(a) The name of the manufacturer;
13	(b) The address of the manufacturer and addresses of
14	each factory owned or operated by the manufacturer, if
15	different from the address of the manufacturer;
16	(c) If a corporation, the state of original
17	incorporation, a list of the names and addresses of all
18	officers and directors of the corporation, and proof of the

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19 filing of all franchise and sales tax forms required by 20 Missouri law;

(d) If not a corporation, the name and address of the managing person or persons responsible for overall operation of the manufacturer;

(2) Files with the commission an initial registration
fee [of seven hundred fifty dollars] in the form of a
cashier's check or money order made payable to the state of
Missouri in an amount established by the commission not to
exceed the costs of administration, inspection, and other
expenses necessary for the administration of sections
700.010 to 700.115.

31 3. The commission shall issue a certificate of32 registration to a dealer who:

33 (1) Completes and files with the commission an 34 application for registration which contains the following 35 information:

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(a) The name of the dealer;

37 (b) The business address of the dealer and addresses 38 of each separate facility owned and operated by the dealer 39 from which manufactured homes or modular units are offered 40 for sale if different from the business address of the 41 dealer;

42 (c) If a corporation, the state of original
43 incorporation, a list of the names and addresses of all
44 officers and directors of the corporation, proof of the
45 filing of all franchise and sales tax forms required by
46 Missouri law;

47 (d) If not a corporation, the name and address of the
48 managing person or persons responsible for the overall
49 operations of the manufacturer;

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50 (2) Files with the commission an initial registration 51 fee [of two hundred dollars] in the form of a cashier's 52 check or money order made payable to the state of Missouri 53 in an amount established by the commission not to exceed the 54 costs of administration, inspection, and other expenses 55 necessary for the administration of sections 700.010 to 56 700.115;

57 (3) Files with the commission proof of compliance with58 the provisions of section 301.280.

59 4. The registration of any manufacturer or dealer shall be effective for a period of one year and shall be 60 renewed by the commission upon receipt by it from the 61 registered dealer or manufacturer of a renewal fee [of seven 62 hundred fifty dollars for manufacturers and two hundred 63 64 dollars for dealers] in an amount established by the 65 commission not to exceed the costs of administration, 66 inspection, and other expenses necessary for the administration of sections 700.010 to 700.115 and a form 67 68 provided by the commission upon which shall be placed any changes from the information requested on the initial 69 70 registration form.

5. The commission may stagger the renewal of
certificates of registration to provide for more equal
distribution over the twelve months of the number of
registration renewals.

700.095. 1. Every dealer shall, on or before January fifteenth of each year, make application for registration or renewal and shall be required to maintain a bona fide established place of business and maintain a permanent enclosed building or structure, either owned in fee or leased and actually occupied as a place of business by the applicant for the selling, bartering, trading, or exchanging

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8 of manufactured homes or modular units where the public may 9 contact the owner or operator at any reasonable time and 10 where the books, records, files, and other matter required 11 and necessary to conduct the business shall be kept and 12 maintained.

13 2. The application shall contain the business address,
14 not a post office box address, and telephone number of the
15 place where the books, records, files, and other matters
16 required and necessary to conduct the business are located
17 and where the same may be inspected during normal daytime
18 business hours.

3. Each application shall contain such additional
information as may be required by the commission to enable
it to determine whether the applicant is a bona fide dealer
in fact and is of good moral character.

4. Upon the payment of a registration or renewal fee
[of two hundred dollars], there shall be assigned to each
dealer a certificate of registration in such form as the
commission shall prescribe.

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
