AN ACT

To repeal section 266.355, RSMo, relating to anhydrous ammonia.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 266.355, RSMo, is repealed, to read as follows:

2 [266.355. Unless provided for by federal law, rule or
3 regulation, the director of the department of agriculture shall
4 promulgate, pursuant to chapter 536, and enforce regulations
5 setting forth minimum general standards covering the design,
6 construction, location, installation, and operation of equipment for
7 storing, handling, transporting by tank truck, tank trailer, tank car
8 and utilizing anhydrous ammonia. The provisions of this section
9 shall not apply to equipment which is in use for storing anhydrous
10 ammonia as of August 28, 2010, and which is found by the
11 department to be in substantial compliance with generally accepted
12 standards of safety regarding life and property. The department
13 shall adopt the minimum general safety standards for the storage
14 and handling of anhydrous ammonia set forth in ANSI Standard
15 K61.1-1999, Safety Requirements for the Storage and Handling of
16 Anhydrous Ammonia; except that, ANSI Standard K61.1-1999 shall
17 not be adopted by the department prior to December 1, 2012. For
18 purposes of this section, "ANSI" means the American National
Standards Institute.]
