## **AN ACT**

To amend chapter 162, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to school bus transportation safety.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 162, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto

  - 162.066. 1. There is hereby established the "Joint
- 2 Task Force on School Bus Safety" to study school bus
- 3 transportation safety in public schools. The task force
- 4 members shall be appointed as follows:
- 5 (1) Two members of the house of representatives
- 6 appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives;
- 7 (2) Two members of the senate appointed by the
- 8 president pro tempore of the senate;
- 9 (3) The commissioner of education or his or her
- 10 designee;
- 11 (4) The director of the department of transportation
- 12 or his or her designee; and
- 13 (5) The director of the department of public safety or
- 14 his or her designee.
- 15 2. The members of the task force shall meet within
- 16 thirty days after its creation to organize and select one
- 17 member to serve as chair.

- 3. Beginning January 1, 2022, the task force shall
- 19 meet at least three times annually to complete its
- 20 consideration of its objectives under the provisions of this
- 21 section. Members of the task force shall serve without
- 22 compensation, but shall be entitled to reimbursement for
- 23 actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of
- 24 their official duties.
- 25 4. The task force shall develop an annual report
- 26 analyzing school bus transportation safety in public
- 27 schools, including:

- 28 (1) Entrance and exit safety;
  - (2) Effectiveness of seat belts; and
- 30 (3) Other school bus transportation safety issues
- 31 deemed worthy by the chair.
- 5. Beginning January 1, 2022, the task force shall
- 33 submit its report to the governor and general assembly by
- 34 December thirty-first annually.
