## **ANACT**

To amend chapter 44, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the exercise of religion during an emergency.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 44, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto

  - 44.103. 1. Notwithstanding section 1.302 to the
- 2 contrary, the state, any state agency, political
- 3 subdivision, county commission, county health board, or
- 4 person shall be prohibited from enacting, adopting,
- 5 maintaining, or enforcing any order, ordinance, rule,
- 6 regulation, policy, or other similar measure that restricts,
- 7 directly or indirectly, the free exercise of religion,
- 8 including limitations on attendance or participation in any
- 9 prayer, service, meeting, or similar religious activity or
- 10 requirements regarding choice of attire or appearance,
- 11 during an emergency related to the entrance of infectious,
- 12 contagious, communicable, or dangerous diseases.
- During an emergency relating to the entrance of
- 14 infectious, contagious, communicable, or dangerous diseases,
- 15 any religious organization in this state shall not be liable
- 16 for civil damages in any action arising out of an exposure
- 17 or potential exposure to the disease warranting such
- 18 emergency on the premises of the religious organization,

- 19 except for willful and wanton misconduct or gross negligence
- 20 by the religious organization. For purposes of this
- 21 subsection, a "religious organization" means any church,
- 22 synagogue, mosque, or any entity that has or would qualify
- 23 for federal tax-exempt status as a nonprofit religious
- 24 organization under Section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue
