AN ACT

To repeal section 9.010, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the establishment of a deer season holiday.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 9.010, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 9.010, to read as follows:

- 9.010. 1. The first day of January, the third Monday of January, the
- 2 twelfth day of February, the third Monday in February, the eighth day of May,
- 3 the last Monday in May, the fourth day of July, the first Monday in September,
- 4 the second Monday in October, the eleventh day of November, the fourth
- 5 Thursday in November, and the twenty-fifth of December, are declared and
- 6 established public holidays; and when any of such holidays falls upon Sunday, the
- 7 Monday next following shall be considered the holiday. There shall be no holiday
- 8 for state employees on the fourth Monday of October.
- 9 2. The first day designated by the conservation commission
- 10 under 3 CSR 10-7.433 for firearms deer hunting season allowing
- 11 permittees to use any legal deer hunting method to take deer statewide
- 12 shall be considered a public holiday. If such day falls upon Saturday
- 13 or Sunday, the Friday prior shall be considered the holiday.
