AN ACT

To amend chapter 487, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to family court participants participating in the medical marijuana program.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 487, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto

- 2 one new section, to be known as section 487.205, to read as
- 3 follows:
 - 487.205. 1. As used in this section, "medical
- 2 marijuana" means the use of medical marijuana in compliance
- 3 with Article XIV of the Constitution of Missouri by a
- 4 qualified patient with a valid medical marijuana
- 5 certification.
- 6 2. If a family court participant requires treatment
- 7 for a qualified medical condition in accordance with Article
- 8 XIV of the Constitution of Missouri, a family court shall
- 9 not prohibit such participant from participating in
- 10 Missouri's medical marijuana program. A family court
- 11 participant shall not be required to refrain from using
- 12 medical marijuana as a term or condition of successful
- 13 completion of the family court program.
- 14 3. A family court participant who is a qualified
- 15 patient with a valid medical marijuana certification shall
- 16 not be in violation of the terms or conditions of the family
- 17 court on the basis of his or her participation in Missouri's
- 18 medical marijuana program.

4. The status and conduct of a qualified patient who
acts in accordance with Article XIV of the Constitution of
Missouri shall not, by itself, be used to restrict or
abridge custodial or parental rights to minor children in
any action or proceeding under the jurisdiction of a family
court under this chapter or a juvenile court under chapter
25 211.
