AN ACT

To amend chapter 167, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to ultraprocessed food in schools.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 167, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto

- 2 one new section, to be known as section 167.207, to read as
- 3 follows:
 - 167.207. 1. This section shall be known and may be
- 2 cited as the "Missouri Healthy Schools Act".
- For the purposes of this section, "ultraprocessed
- 4 food" means a food or beverage that contains one or more of
- 5 the following ingredients:
- 6 (1) Potassium bromate;
- 7 (2) Propylparaben;
- 8 (3) Titanium dioxide;
- 9 (4) Brominated vegetable oil;
- 10 **(5)** Yellow dye 5;
- 11 (6) Yellow dye 6;
- 12 **(7)** Blue dye 1;
- 13 (8) Blue dye 2;
- 14 (9) Green dye 3;
- 15 (10) Red dye 3;
- 16 (11) Red dye 40.
- 3. Beginning in the 2026-2027 school year and for all
- 18 subsequent school years, any school that participates in a

- 19 federally funded or assisted meal program shall not serve,
- 20 sell, or allow a third party to sell ultraprocessed food on
- 21 the school campus during the school day. This subsection
- 22 shall not be construed to prohibit a student's parent or
- 23 guardian from providing ultraprocessed food to the student
- 24 during the school day.
- 25 4. The department of elementary and secondary
- 26 education shall post on the department's website both of the
- 27 following:
- 28 (1) A standardized form that a public school may use
- 29 to certify that the public school is complying with the
- 30 requirements of this section; and
- 31 (2) A list of each public school that has certified to
- 32 the department that the public school is complying with the
- 33 requirements of this section.
