### AN ACT

To amend chapter 191, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to gender reassignment for children under eighteen years of age.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 191, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 191.1180, to read as follows:

191.1180. 1. Any physician or surgeon licensed under chapter

- 5 puberty blockers, prescribing hormone therapy, performing a

- 7 hysterectomy, or performing other genital or hormonal interventions
- 8 for the purpose of gender reassignment for a child. As used in this
- 9 section, "child" means a person under eighteen years of age.
- 2. Any licensed physician or surgeon, any person licensed to

- 12 personnel who willfully and knowingly does or assists any prohibited
- 13 action under subsection 1 of this section shall be subject to having his
- 14 or her license, application for license, or authority to practice his or

- 16 in the state of Missouri rejected or revoked by the appropriate state
- 17 licensing board.

- 21 if he or she obtains medical or surgical treatment prohibited under
