AN ACT

To amend chapter 208, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the establishment of a supplemental nutrition assistance pilot program.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 208, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new $\mathbf{2}$ section, to be known as section 208.018, to read as follows:

208.018. 1. Subject to federal approval, the department of social services shall establish a pilot program for the purpose of providing $\mathbf{2}$ Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) participants with 3 access and the ability to afford fresh fruit and vegetables when 4 purchasing fresh produce at farmers' markets. Under the pilot 5program, such participants shall be able to: 6

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(1) Purchase fresh produce with SNAP benefits with an electronic benefit transfer (EBT) card; and 8

9 (2) Receive a dollar-for-dollar match for every SNAP dollar spent at a participating farmer's market in an amount up to ten dollars 10 per week whenever the participant purchases fresh produce with an 11 12EBT card.

2. Purchases of approved fresh produce by SNAP participants 13under this section shall automatically trigger matching funds 14reimbursement into the vendor accounts by the department. 15

16 3. The funding of this pilot program shall be subject to appropriation. In addition to appropriations from the general 17 18 assembly, the department may apply for available grants and shall be 19 able to accept other gifts, grants, and donations to develop and 20maintain the program.

4. The department shall promulgate rules setting forth the

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22procedures and methods of implementing this section. Any rule or 23portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is 24created under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions 2526of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the 27general assembly pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the 28effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held 29unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule 30 proposed or adopted after August 28, 2014, shall be invalid and void. 31

5. Pursuant to section 23.253 of the Missouri sunset act:

33 (1) The provisions of this section shall sunset automatically six years after the effective date of this section unless reauthorized by an 34act of the general assembly; and 35

36 (2) If such program is reauthorized, the program authorized 37 under this section shall sunset automatically twelve years after the effective date of the reauthorization of this section; and 38

39 (3) This section shall terminate on September first of the 40 calendar year immediately following the calendar year in which the program authorized under this section is sunset. 41

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
