AN ACT

To repeal section 300.320, RSMo, relating to the identification of funeral processions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 300.320, RSMo, is repealed, to read as follows:

2 [300.320. A funeral composed of a procession of vehicles
3 shall be identified as such by the display upon the outside of each
4 vehicle of a pennant or other identifying insignia or by such other
5 method as may be determined and designated by the traffic
 division.]
