AN ACT

To amend chapter 192, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to sepsis protocols.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 192, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 192.680, to read as follows:

192.680. 1. Every hospital, as defined in section 197.020 but not including a mental health facility as defined in section 632.005, shall,

3 in consultation with its medical staff, adopt, implement, and

4 periodically update evidence-based protocols for the early recognition

and treatment of patients with sepsis, severe sepsis, or septic shock.

- 2. Hospitals shall ensure that all relevant staff are trained to implement the sepsis protocols established under this section.
- 3. The department of health and senior services shall not promulgate any rules or regulations on sepsis protocols but may require hospitals to provide documentation of the adoption of sepsis protocols.
- 4. A hospital shall not be held liable in any way for any acts or omissions as a result of the provisions of this section.

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
