## AN ACT

To amend chapter 338, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to dispensing maintenance medication.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

2. For the purposes of this section "maintenance medication" is a medication prescribed for chronic, long-term conditions and is taken on a regular, recurring basis, except that it shall not include controlled
