AN ACT

To amend chapter 188, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to pregnancy-related services.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 188, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto

 - 188.345. 1. This section shall be known and may be

- 3 2. For purposes of this section, the term "medically
- 4 accurate information" shall mean information that is:
- 5 (1) Verified or supported by the weight of medical
- 6 research conducted in compliance with accepted scientific
- 7 methods;
- 8 (2) Recognized as correct and objective by leading
- 9 medical organizations with relevant expertise or government
- 10 agencies, such as the:
- 11 (a) American Medical Association;
- 12 (b) American Congress of Obstetricians and
- 13 Gynecologists;
- 14 (c) American Public Health Association;
- 15 (d) American Academy of Pediatrics;
- 16 (e) American College of Physicians;
- 17 (f) American Academy of Family Physicians;
- (g) Centers for Disease Control and Prevention;

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19 (h) Food and Drug Administration;

- 20 (i) National Cancer Institute;
- 21 (j) American Psychological Association; or
- 22 (k) National Institute for Health; or
- 23 (3) Recommended by or affirmed in the medical practice
- 24 guidelines of a nationally recognized accrediting
- 25 organization, such as the:

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- 26 (a) Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare
 27 Organizations (JCAHO);
- 28 (b) National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA);
- 29 (c) American Accreditation HealthCare Commission or 30 Utilization Review Accreditation Commission (AAHC/URAC); or
- (d) Accreditation Association for AmbulatoryHealthCare (AAAHC).
 - 3. To be eligible for state funds, all organizations that provide pregnancy-related services or counseling, including those that provide services or counseling under the alternatives to abortion services program described in section 188.325, shall provide program participants with medically accurate and unbiased information on all relevant reproductive health options, including, but not limited to, information about family planning, birth control, pregnancy, abortion, adoption, labor and delivery, and postpartum care.
 - 4. Any organization that provides pregnancy-related services or counseling, including an organization that provides services or counseling under the alternatives to abortion services program, that violates the provisions of this section shall not be eligible to receive any state funding or tax incentives, including, but not limited to, temporary assistance for needy families funds or tax credits.
