Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri, an amendment to article X of the Constitution of Missouri, by adding thereto one new section relating to local taxation.

Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring therein:

That at the next general election to be held in the

- 2 state of Missouri, on Tuesday next following the first Monday
- 3 in November, 2022, or at a special election to be called by
- 4 the governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted to
- 5 the qualified voters of this state, for adoption or
- 6 rejection, the following amendment to article X of the
- 7 Constitution of the state of Missouri:

Section A. Article X, Constitution of Missouri, is amended

- 2 by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 27,
- 3 to read as follows:

Section 27. In any county, municipality, or special

- 2 taxing district which levies a dedicated property tax or
- 3 sales tax specifically for the provision of emergency
- 4 services, and whose boundaries overlap the boundaries of
- 5 another county, municipality, or special taxing district
- 6 which also levies a dedicated property tax or sales tax for
- 7 the same purpose, persons residing within such overlapping
- 8 boundaries shall only remit such property tax or sales tax
- 9 to one taxing jurisdiction. The local election authority or
- 10 authorities with jurisdiction over the overlapping
- 11 boundaries shall submit to the voters living within the

12 overlapping boundaries the question of from which political

13 subdivision such voters shall continue to receive services

14 and to which political subdivision the voters shall remit

15 the tax.
