## JOINT RESOLUTION

Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri, an amendment to article X of the Constitution of Missouri, by adding thereto one new section relating to local taxation.

*Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring therein:*

That at the next general election to be held in the  
2 state of Missouri, on Tuesday next following the first Monday  
3 in November, 2022, or at a special election to be called by  
4 the governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted to  
5 the qualified voters of this state, for adoption or  
6 rejection, the following amendment to article X of the  
7 Constitution of the state of Missouri:

Section A. Article X, Constitution of Missouri, is amended  
2 by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 27,  
3 to read as follows:

**Section 27. In any county, municipality, or special  
2 taxing district which levies a dedicated property tax or  
3 sales tax specifically for the provision of emergency  
4 services, and whose boundaries overlap the boundaries of  
5 another county, municipality, or special taxing district  
6 which also levies a dedicated property tax or sales tax for  
7 the same purpose, persons residing within such overlapping  
8 boundaries shall only remit such property tax or sales tax  
9 to one taxing jurisdiction. The local election authority or  
10 authorities with jurisdiction over the overlapping  
11 boundaries shall submit to the voters living within the**

12 overlapping boundaries the question of from which political  
13 subdivision such voters shall continue to receive services  
14 and to which political subdivision the voters shall remit  
15 the tax.
