## JOINT RESOLUTION

Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri, an amendment repealing section 25(a) of article V of the Constitution of Missouri, and adopting one new section in lieu thereof relating to the nonpartisan court plan.

Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring therein:

That at the next general election to be held in the state of Missouri, on

- 2 Tuesday next following the first Monday in November, 2016, or at a special
- 3 election to be called by the governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted
- 4 to the qualified voters of this state, for adoption or rejection, the following
- 5 amendment to article V of the Constitution of the state of Missouri:

Section A. Section 25(a), article V, Constitution of Missouri, is repealed

- 2 and one new section adopted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 25(a), to read
- 3 as follows:

Section 25(a). Whenever a vacancy shall occur in the office of judge of any

- 2 of the following courts of this state, to wit: The supreme court, the court of
- 3 appeals, or in the office of circuit or associate circuit judge within the city of St.
- 4 Louis and Jackson County, the governor shall fill such vacancy by appointing one
- 5 [of three persons] **person** possessing the qualifications for such office, who shall
- 6 be nominated [and whose] from a list of names [shall be] submitted to the
- 7 governor by a nonpartisan judicial commission established and organized as
- 8 hereinafter provided. If the governor fails to appoint any of the nominees within
- 9 sixty days after the list of nominees is submitted, the nonpartisan judicial
- 10 commission making the nomination shall appoint one of the nominees to fill the
- 11 vacancy.

constitutional provisions and laws of this state authorizing the general assembly
to adopt ballot language for the submission of a joint resolution to the voters of

"Shall the Missouri Constitution be amended to allow a
nonpartisan judicial commission to send a list of an unlimited
number of qualified candidates to the governor, as opposed to the
current limitation of three candidates, from which the governor
