## JOINT RESOLUTION

Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri, an amendment to article I of the Constitution of Missouri, by adding thereto one new section relating to the right of individuals to refuse any medical procedure or treatment.

*Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring therein:*

That at the next general election to be held in the  
2 state of Missouri, on Tuesday next following the first Monday  
3 in November, 2024, or at a special election to be called by  
4 the governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted to  
5 the qualified voters of this state, for adoption or  
6 rejection, the following amendment to article I of the  
7 Constitution of the state of Missouri:

Section A. Article I, Constitution of Missouri, is amended  
2 by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 36,  
3 to read as follows:

**Section 36. That no law, order, ordinance, regulation,  
2 or public policy shall be passed or implemented by the state  
3 or any political subdivision of the state, including, but  
4 not limited to, schools and institutions of higher education  
5 receiving public funds, that infringes upon the  
6 unquestionable right of individuals to refuse any medical  
7 procedure or treatment, including, but not limited to,  
8 injections, vaccines, or prophylactics. Equality of rights  
9 under the law shall not be denied or abridged to any person  
10 in this state because of the exercise of the right under**

11 **this section. Nothing in this section shall be interpreted**  
12 **to infringe upon a parent's right to exercise control over**  
13 **their minor, unemancipated child's physical and mental care.**

Section B. Pursuant to chapter 116, and other  
2 applicable constitutional provisions and laws of this state  
3 allowing the general assembly to adopt ballot language for  
4 the submission of this joint resolution to the voters of  
5 this state, the official summary statement of this  
6 resolution shall be as follows:

7 "Shall the Missouri Constitution be amended to  
8 prohibit any laws, orders, ordinances,  
9 regulations, or public policies that infringe  
10 upon the unquestionable right of individuals to  
11 refuse any medical procedure or treatment,  
12 including injections, vaccines, or  
13 prophylactics?"
