9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	Section 1. Section 46-24-213, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"46-24-213. General requirements for information. (1) Unless specifically stated otherwise, the
13	requirements of 44-2-601, 46-24-104, 46-24-201 through 46-24-203, 46-24-211, and 46-24-212 to provide
14	information to the victim may be satisfied by either written, e-mail ELECTRONIC, or oral communication with the
15	victim or the victim's designee.
16	(2) The person responsible for providing information required by 44-2-601, 46-24-104, 46-24-201 through
17	46-24-203, 46-24-211, and 46-24-212 shall promptly inform the victim of significant changes in the information.
18	(3) The obligation to furnish information to a victim under 44-2-601, 46-24-104, 46-24-201 through
19	46-24-203, 46-24-211, and 46-24-212 is conditioned upon the victim informing the appropriate agency in writing
20	or by electronic mail MEANS of the name, mailing address, e-mail ELECTRONIC address, if applicable, and
21	telephone number of the person to whom the information should be provided and of any change of name, mailing
22	or e-mail ELECTRONIC address, or telephone number."
