13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

15	Sectio	n 1. Section 2-3-214, MCA, is amended to read:	
16	"2-3-21	14. Recording of meetings for certain boards. (1) Except as provided in 2-3-203, the	
17	following boards shall record their public meetings in a an audio and video or audio format:		
18	(a)	the board of investments provided for in 2-15-1808;	
19	(b)	the public employees' retirement board provided for in 2-15-1009;	
20	(c)	the teachers' retirement board provided for in 2-15-1010;	
21	(d)	the board of public education provided for in Article X, section 9, of the Montana constitution;	
22	and		
23	(e)	the board of regents of higher education provided for in Article X, section 9, of the Montana	
24	constitution;		
25	<u>(f)</u>	the governing board of a county provided for in Title 7, chapter 1, part 21;	
26	<u>(g)</u>	the governing board of a municipality provided for in Title 7, chapter 1, part 41;	
27	<u>(h)</u>	a school district board of trustees provided for in Article X, section 8, of the Montana	
28	constitution; and

1	(i) a local board of health provided for in Title 50, chapter 2, part 1.		
2	(2) All good faith efforts to record meetings in a video format must be made, but if a board is unable to		
3	record a meeting in a video format, it must record the meeting in an audio format.		
4	(3)(2) (a) The boards listed in subsection (1) must shall make the audio and video or audio recordings		
5	of meetings under subsection (1) publicly available within 1 business day after the meeting through broadcast		
6	on the state government broadcasting service as provided in 5-11-1111 or through publication of streaming		
7	audio and video or audio-content on the respective board's website.		
8	(b) The department of administration may develop a memorandum of understanding with the		
9	legislative services division for broadcasting executive branch content on the state government broadcasting		
10	service or live-streaming audio or and video executive branch content over the internet."

12	Section 2. Section 7-1-4141, MCA, is amended to read:		
13	"7-1-4141. Public meeting required. (1) All meetings of municipal governing bodies, boards,		
14	authorities, committees, or other entities created by a municipality shall-must be open to the public except as		
15	provided in 2-3-203.		
16	(2) Appropriate Subject to the requirements of 2-3-214, appropriate minutes shall must be kept of		
17	all public meetings and shall-must be made available upon on request to the public for inspection and copying."

19	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated \$271,500 from the state general		
20	fund to the department of administration for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023. The appropriation must be		
21	used to provide \$500 grants to the government agencies listed in [section 1(1)(f) through (1)(i)] for the purposes		
22	of purchasing audio and video recording equipment, training staff, and updating processes to comply with the		
23	requirements of [section 1]. Any funds remaining as of June 30, 2024, must revert to the general fund.

25	NEW SECTION. Section 4. Effective date. [This act] is effective July 1, 2023.
