12	The department shall classify reported incidents involving a large predator, as defined in 87-1-217, into one of						
13	the following categories:						
14	(a) an incident resulting in human injury or immediate threat to human safety;						
15	(b) an incident resulting in depredation of livestock, including beehives and domestic animals; or						
16	(c) an incident involving other circumstances.						
17	(2) If the department classifies a large predator incident subject to subsection (1)(a), the department						
18	shall:						
19	(a) notify emergency medical services personnel;						
20	(b) notify county commissioners and the sheriff in the county where the incident occurred; and						
21	(c) destroy the large predator.						
22	(3) If the department classifies a large predator incident subject to subsection (1)(b), the department						
23	shall:						
24	(a) notify county commissioners and the sheriff in the county where the incident occurred; and						
25	(b) destroy the large predator.						
26	(4) If the department classifies a large predator incident subject to subsection (1)(c), the department shall						
27	attach identification tags to the large predator before transplantation.
