| 10 | Section 1. Section 61-10-103, MCA, is amended to read: |
| 11 | "61-10-103. Height. A (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), a vehicle, unladen or with load, may not |
| 12 | exceed a height of 14 feet. |
| 13 | (2) Subsection (1) does not apply to AN IMPLEMENT OF HUSBANDRY OR a vehicle, unladen or with load, THAT |
| 14 | DOES NOT EXCEED A HEIGHT OF 15 FEET 6 INCHES If: |
| 15 | (a) the IMPLEMENT OF HUSBANDRY OR vehicle is transporting or returning from transporting agricultural |
| 16 | products HAY, STRAW, OR BOTH ON A TWO-LANE HIGHWAY from a point of loading to a point of unloading not more |
| 17 | than 150 miles apart; FOR A DISTANCE NOT MORE THAN 100 MILES AND IS INCIDENTAL TO FARMING OPERATIONS; AND |
| 18 | (b) THE IMPLEMENT OF HUSBANDRY OR the vehicle does not encounter overhead obstacles WILL NOT |
| 19 | ENCOUNTER OVERHEAD OBSTACLES 17 FEET FROM THE GROUND OR LOWER WHILE in transit; and. |
| 20 | (c) the vehicle and its load are secured in a manner to prevent hazards to persons or property." |
