4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REVISING LAWS RELATED TO BICYCLE SAFETY AND PASSING
5	VEHICLES; AND AMENDING SECTIONS 61-8-320 AND 61-8-321, MCA."
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7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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9	Section 1. Section 61-8-320, MCA, is amended to read:
10	"61-8-320. Right-of-way for bicycles safely passing. (1) The operator of a motor vehicle may not:
11	(a) intentionally interfere with the movement of a person who is lawfully riding a bicycle; or
12	(b) overtake and pass a person riding a bicycle unless the operator of the motor vehicle can do so safely
13	without endangering the person riding the bicycle by maintaining at all times a minimum distance of 4 feet
14	between the vehicle and the bicycle and its operator.
15	(2) The operator of a motor vehicle shall yield the right-of-way to a person who is riding a bicycle within
16	a designated bicycle lane."
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18	Section 2. Section 61-8-321, MCA, is amended to read:
19	"61-8-321. Drive on right side of roadway exceptions. (1) Upon all roadways of sufficient width, a
20	vehicle must be operated upon the right half of the roadway, except as follows:
21	(a) when overtaking and passing another vehicle proceeding in the same direction under the rules
22	governing the passing movement;
23	(b) when the right half of a roadway is closed to traffic while under construction or repair;
24	(c) upon a roadway divided into three marked lanes for traffic under the rules applicable on a divided
25	roadway;
26	(d) upon a roadway designated by official traffic control devices for one-way traffic;
27	(e) when the operator of a vehicle is complying with the provisions of 61-8-320 or 61-8-346; or
28	(f) when an obstruction exists that makes it necessary to drive to the left of the center of the roadway.
29	(2) A person operating a vehicle to the left of the center of the roadway for any of the reasons provided
30	in subsection (1) shall yield the right-of-way to all vehicles traveling in the proper direction upon the unobstructed

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1 portion of the roadway that are within a distance that constitutes an immediate hazard.

(3) A vehicle proceeding at less than the normal speed of traffic at the time and place and under the
conditions then existing must be operated in the right-hand lane then available for traffic, or as close as
practicable to the right-hand curb or edge of the roadway except when overtaking and passing another vehicle
proceeding in the same direction or when preparing for a left turn at an intersection or into a private road or
driveway."
