4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT CLARIFYING THAT VEHICLES TRAVELING ON ROADWAYS WITH
5	TWO OR MORE LANES OF TRAFFIC MOVING IN THE SAME DIRECTION MUST STAY IN THE RIGHT LANE
6	WITH CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS; AND AMENDING SECTION 61-8-321, MCA."

8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
9	
10	Section 1. Section 61-8-321, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"61-8-321. Drive on right side of roadway exceptions. (1) Upon all roadways of sufficient width, a
12	vehicle must be operated upon the right half of the roadway, except as follows:
13	(a) when overtaking and passing another vehicle proceeding in the same direction under the rules
14	governing the passing movement;
15	(b) when the right half of a roadway is closed to traffic while under construction or repair;
16	(c) upon a roadway divided into three marked lanes for traffic under the rules applicable on a divided
17	roadway;
18	(d) upon a roadway designated by official traffic control devices for one-way traffic;
19	(e) when the operator of a vehicle is complying with the provisions of 61-8-346; or
20	(f) when an obstruction exists that makes it necessary to drive to the left of the center of the roadway.
21	(2) A person operating a vehicle to the left of the center of the roadway for any of the reasons provided
22	in subsection (1) shall yield the right-of-way to all vehicles traveling in the proper direction upon the unobstructed
23	portion of the roadway that are within a distance that constitutes an immediate hazard.
24	(3) A vehicle proceeding at less than the normal speed of traffic at the time and place and under the
25	conditions then existing must be operated in the right-hand lane then available for traffic, or as close as
26	practicable to the right-hand curb or edge of the roadway except when overtaking and passing another vehicle
27	proceeding in the same direction or when preparing for a left turn at an intersection or into a private road or
28	driveway. Upon all roadways having two or more lanes for traffic moving in the same direction, a vehicle must
29	be driven in the right-hand lane except when:
30	(a) overtaking and passing another vehicle proceeding in the same direction;

- 1 (b) traveling at a speed greater than the traffic flow;
- 2 (c) moving left to allow traffic to merge; or
- 3 (d) preparing for a left turn at an intersection or into a private road or driveway when a left turn is legally

4 permitted."
