4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REQUIRING RABIES VACCINATIONS FOR CERTAIN DOMESTIC

7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Rabies vaccination required exceptions. (1) Domestic cats, dogs, and
10	ferrets must be vaccinated against rabies within 30 days after reaching 3 months of age and must be kept
11	vaccinated against rabies by a state-licensed veterinarian in accordance with vaccination recommendations
12	contained in the most recently published edition of the Compendium of Animal Rabies Prevention and Control,
13	published by the centers for disease control and prevention, U.S. department of health and human services. The
14	requirement to vaccinate against rabies applies to cats, dogs, and ferrets that are born in this state or that are
15	brought into this state.
16	(2) This section does not prohibit or limit a local health board, municipality, or county from establishing
17	by ordinance or resolution requirements for the implementation and enforcement of rabies control that are more
18	stringent than the provisions of this section.

20	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
21	integral part of Title 50, chapter 23, part 1, and the provisions of Title 50, chapter 23, part 1, apply to [section 1].

23	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective July 1, 2013.
