9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	Section 1. Section 7-14-2113, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"7-14-2113. County authority to establish speed limits and regulate use of compression brakes
13	A board of county commissioners may, by ordinance, establish:
14	(1) a special speed limit in accordance with 61-8-310 on any county road;
15	(2) regulations on the use of compression brakes on any highway, as defined in 61-1-101, within the
16	county. A violation of regulations adopted to implement this subsection is punishable as provided in 61-9-521.

18	Section 2. Section 61-9-321, MCA, is amended to read:
19	"61-9-321. Engine compression brake device use. (1) A commercial motor vehicle equipped with
20	an engine compression brake device must be equipped with a muffler in good working condition to preven
21	excessive noise.
22	(2) An Except as provided for in 7-14-2113, an operator of a commercial motor vehicle that has an
23	engine compression brake device with a factory-installed muffler or an equivalent after-market muffler may no
24	be prohibited from using the engine compression brake device.
25	(3) The department of transportation employees who are designated as peace officers pursuant to
26	61-10-154 shall work with law enforcement in the enforcement of standards adopted pursuant to this section.
27	(4) Notice of a deficiency must be given pursuant to 61-9-501.
28	(5) A violation of the rules adopted to implement to this section is punishable as provided in 61-9-521.

1 "61-9-521. Violation of engine compression brake device provisions -- penalty. A person who

2 violates the provisions of 61-9-321 or regulations adopted pursuant to 7-14-2113 is guilty of a misdemeanor and

3 upon conviction shall be fined not to exceed \$500."
