10	Section 1. Section 25-13-609, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"25-13-609. Personal property exempt subject to value limitations. A judgment debtor is entitled
12	to exemption from execution of the following:
13	(1) the judgment debtor's interest, not to exceed \$4,500 <u>\$6,000</u> <u>\$7,000</u> in aggregate value, to the
14	extent of a value not exceeding \$600 <u>\$1,000</u> <u>\$1,250</u> in any item of property, in household furnishings and
15	goods, appliances, jewelry, wearing apparel, books, firearms and other sporting goods, animals, feed, crops,
16	and musical instruments;
17	(2) the judgment debtor's interest, not to exceed \$2,500 \$3,500 \$4,000 in value, in one motor vehicle;
18	and
19	(3) the judgment debtor's interest, not to exceed \$3,000 <u>\$4,000</u> <u>\$4,500</u> in aggregate value, in any
20	implements, professional books, and tools, of the trade of the judgment debtor or a dependent of the judgment
21	debtor."
