

AN ACT REVISING CIVIL LIABILITY LAWS; INCREASING THE VALUE OF CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY EXEMPT FROM EXECUTION; AMENDING SECTION 25-13-609, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 25-13-609, MCA, is amended to read:

"25-13-609. Personal property exempt subject to value limitations. A judgment debtor is entitled to exemption from execution of the following:

(1) the judgment debtor's interest, not to exceed \$4,500 \$7,000 in aggregate value, to the extent of a value not exceeding \$600 \$1,250 in any item of property, in household furnishings and goods, appliances, jewelry, wearing apparel, books, firearms and other sporting goods, animals, feed, crops, and musical instruments;

- (2) the judgment debtor's interest, not to exceed \$2,500 \$4,000 in value, in one motor vehicle; and
- (3) the judgment debtor's interest, not to exceed \$3,000 \$4,500 in aggregate value, in any

implements, professional books, and tools, of the trade of the judgment debtor or a dependent of the judgment debtor."

Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
