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11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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13	Section 1. Section 16-4-406, MCA, is amended to read:
14	"16-4-406. Renewal suspension or revocation penalty. (1) The Except as provided in subsection
15	(3), the department shall upon a written, verified complaint of a person request that the department of justice
16	investigate the action and operation of a brewer, winery, beer importer, distiller, wholesaler, or any
17	other person or business licensed or registered under this code.
18	(2) Subject to the opportunity for a hearing under the Montana Administrative Procedure Act, if the
19	department, after reviewing admissions of the licensee or receiving the results of the department of justice's or
20	a local law enforcement agency's investigation, has reasonable cause to believe that a licensee has violated a
21	provision of this code or a rule of the department, it may, in its discretion and in addition to the other penalties
22	prescribed:
23	(a) reprimand a licensee;
24	(b) proceed to revoke the license of the licensee;
25	(c) suspend the license for a period of not more than 3 months;
26	(d) refuse to grant a renewal of the license after its expiration; or
27	(e) impose a civil penalty not to exceed \$1,500.
28	(3) This section does not apply to an individual holding a connoisseur's license provided for in 16-4-901."
