9	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Short title. [Sections 1 through 4] may be cited as the "Grant Transparency						
10	Act".

12	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of [sections 1 through 4] is to establish transparency						
13	in the use of taxpayer funds granted to nonstate entities <u>DISTRIBUTED AS GRANTS</u> .

15	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Definitions. As used in [sections 1 through 4], the following definitions						
16	apply:						
17	(1) "Designated state agency" means:						
18	(a) the department of administration;						
19	(b) the department of agriculture;						
20	(c) the arts council;						
21	(d) the office of the state auditor;						
22	(e) the board of regents;						
23	(f) the department of commerce;

- 17 (2) "Grant" means state funds disbursed by a designated state agency as a federal or state grant.

- 19 (4) "State funds" means any money appropriated by the state legislature, any money disbursed by a 20 designated state agency under spending authority authorized by the state legislature, or any federal money that 21 is passed through a designated state agency.

- <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Section 4. Grant reporting -- searchable website.** (1) Following the close of each fiscal year, a designated state agency shall prepare a report that identifies all grants disbursed by the agency in the previous fiscal year.
- 26 (2) The report must provide the following information:
- 27 (a) the amount of each grant;
- 28 (b) the date of the grant;
- 29 (c) the entity receiving the grant;
- 30 (d) the duration of the grant; and

(3) A designated state agency that prepares a report in accordance with subsection (1) shall submit the report to the office of budget and program planning on or before August 1 of each year.

- (4) The office of budget and program planning shall prepare a report that compiles and summarizes the reports that the office of budget and program planning receives in accordance with subsection (3).
- (5) The office of budget and program planning shall submit the report required by subsection (4) to the state administration and veterans' affairs interim committee on or before September 1 of each year. The report must be submitted in an electronic format.
- (6) The report required by subsection (4) shall be posted to a searchable website so that a user may search for grant information by agency, grantee, topic, and title.

NEW SECTION. Section 5. Codification instruction. [Sections 1 through 4] are intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 17, chapter 1, and the provisions of Title 17, chapter 1, apply to [sections 1 through 4].
