4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REQUIRING ALLOWING CUSTOMERS TO OPT-IN FOR
5	ADVANCED METERING GATEWAY DEVICE INSTALLATION; PROVIDING RULEMAKING AUTHORITY;
6	REPEALING SECTION 69-4-1004, MCA; AMENDING SECTIONS 69-4-1001 AND 69-4-1004, MCA; AND
7	PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
10	
11	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Advanced meter METERING GATEWAY DEVICE opt-in provisions
12	rulemaking. (1) A utility shall require-MAY ALLOW customers to opt-in to the installation of all advanced metering
13	GATEWAY devices located at an end user's residence or business.
14	(2) A utility may not charge customers who do not opt-in to advanced metering GATEWAY device
15	installation additional fees or charges related to the customer decision to forego installation.
16	(3) If the commission determines an opt-in program should be established, the commission shall
17	adopt rules providing options, and requirements, AND A PROCESS FOR DETERMINATION OF FEES OR CHARGES for
18	individual customers to opt-in to advanced metering GATEWAY device installation.
19	(4) UTILITIES SEEKING TO ALLOW AN ADVANCED METER METERING GATEWAY DEVICE OPT-IN PROGRAM SHALL
20	FILE A REPORT DETAILING THE PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS AND PROCESS FOR DETERMINING FEES OR CHARGES WITH THE
21	COMMISSION ALONG WITH A \$25 FILING FEE.

23	SECTION 2. SECTION 69-4-1001, MCA, IS AMENDED TO READ:
24	"69-4-1001. Definitions. As used in this part, unless the context requires otherwise, the following
25	definitions apply:
26	(1) "Advanced metering gateway device" means any electric utility meter, electric utility meter
27	component, or device ancillary to the electric utility meter that is located at an end-user's residence or business
28	and is equipped and programmed to communicate with electrical appliances, electrical equipment, or electrical



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1	devices within the end-user's residence or business or that is capable of estimating and recording electrical
2	energy usage by types of appliances, electrical equipment, or electrical devices.
3	(2) "ADVANCED METERING DEVICE" OR "ADVANCED METER" MEANS A METER OR METERING DEVICE THAT IS
4	OWNED OR LEASED BY A UTILITY OR THE UTILITY'S AGENT AND THAT:
5	(A) MEASURES, RECORDS, OR SENDS A CUSTOMER'S UTILITY USAGE OR OTHER DATA BY USE OF RADIO WAVES
6	OR INTERNET TECHNOLOGY; OR AND
7	(B) ALLOWS FOR TWO-WAY COMMUNICATION BETWEEN THE METER AND THE UTILITY OR ITS AGENT.
8	(2)(3) "Utility" means a public utility regulated by the public service commission pursuant to Title 69,
9	chapter 3."
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11	SECTION 3. SECTION 69-4-1004, MCA, IS AMENDED TO READ:
12	"69-4-1004. Opt-out public service commission responsibilities rulemaking. (1) On or before
13	July 1, 2020 2022, the public service commission shall determine whether an opt-out program for ADVANCED
14	METERS OR advanced metering gateway devices, OR BOTH, should be established.
15	(2) In determining whether to establish an opt-out program, the commission shall consider:
16	(a) an individual customer's privacy interest;
17	(b) costs and practicality of allowing customers to opt out;
18	(c) availability of other technology; and
19	(d) other concerns related to advanced metering devices AND ADVANCED METERING GATEWAY DEVICES.
20	(2)(3) If the commission determines an opt-out program should be established, the commission shall
21	adopt rules providing options and requirements for individual customers to opt out of advanced metering DEVICE
22	OR ADVANCED METERING GATEWAY DEVICE installation."

24	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Repealer. The following section of the Montana Code Annotated is
25	repealed:
26	69-4-1004. Opt-out public service commission responsibilities rulemaking.
27	
28	NEW SECTION. Section 4. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an



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1 integral part of Title 69, chapter 4, part 10, and the provisions of Title 69, chapter 4, part 10, apply to [section 1].

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3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Section 5. Effective date.** [This act] is effective on passage and approval.

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
