| 12 | NEW SECTION. Section 1. Seniors affected by covid-19 pandemic additional year of |
| 13 | eligibility. (1) Pursuant to 20-5-101(3), the trustees of the district may admit or retain a pupil who was in 12th |
| 14 | grade during the 2020-2021 school year and who was adversely affected by the covid-19 pandemic. The |
| 15 | trustees are limited to offering this additional year of academic and athletic eligibility to the following number of |
| 16 | students: |
| 17 | (a) for a first-class district under 20-6-301, five students; |
| 18 | (b) for a second-class district under 20-6-301, four students; and |
| 19 | (c) for a third-class district under 20-6-301, three students. |
| 20 | (2) For the purposes of this section, "adversely affected" means a pupil who was in 12th grade during |
| 21 | the 2020-2021 school year who lost eligibility for, had an offer rescinded for, or likely was denied the |
| 22 | opportunity for a scholarship or other financial aid to a postsecondary institution as a result of the covid-19 |
| 23 | pandemic. This includes athletic, academic, or other scholarship or financial aid awards. |
