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9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:		
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11	Section 1. Section 87-1-217, MCA, is amended to read:		
12	"87-1-	217. Policy for management of large predators legislative intent. (1) In managing large	
13	predators, the primary goals of the department, in the order of listed priority, are to:		
14	(a)	protect humans, livestock, and pets;	
15	(b)	preserve and enhance the safety of the public during outdoor recreational and livelihood	
16	activities; and		
17	(c)	preserve citizens' opportunities to hunt large game species.	
18	(2)	With regard to large predators, it is the intent of the legislature that the specific provisions of	
19	this section co	ncerning the management of large predators will control the general supervisory authority of the	
20	department regarding the management of all wildlife.		
21	(3)	For the management of wolves in accordance with the priorities established in subsection (1),	
22	the department may use lethal action to take problem wolves that attack livestock if the state objective for		
23	breeding pairs has been met. For the purposes of this subsection, "problem wolves" means any individual wolf		
24	or pack of wolves with a history of livestock predation.		
25	(4)	The department shall work with the livestock loss board and the United States department of	
26	agriculture wile	dlife services to establish the conditions under which carcasses or parts of carcasses from wolves	
27	or mountain lions are retrieved during management activities and when those carcasses or parts of carcasses		
28	are made available to the livestock loss board for sale or auction pursuant to 2-15-3113.		



1	(5) (a) The department shall ensure that county commissioners and tribal governments in areas	
2	that have identifiable populations of large predators have the opportunity for consultation and coordination with	
3	state and federal agencies prior to state and federal policy decisions involving large predators and large game	
4	species.	
5	(b) At least 30 days before the release or relocation of a large predator within the boundaries of a	
6	county or tribal government, the THE department shall provide verbal and written notice to the county	
7	commissioners, sheriff's office, and tribal government located within the county or tribal government boundaries	
8	where the A large predator is to be released or relocated:	
9	(I) ON THE FINALIZATION OF AN ANNUAL PLAN TO RELOCATE A LARGE PREDATOR INTO A COUNTY OR	
10	TRIBAL GOVERNMENT BOUNDARY OTHER THAN THE ONE IT WAS CAPTURED IN;	
11	(II) ON THE FINALIZATION OF A CHANGE TO A PLAN TO RELOCATE A LARGE PREDATOR INTO A COUNTY OR	
12	TRIBAL GOVERNMENT BOUNDARY OTHER THAN THE ONE IT WAS CAPTURED IN;	
13	(III) WITHIN 24 HOURS OF THE CAPTURE OF A LARGE PREDATOR IF IT WILL BE RELOCATED INTO A COUNTY	
14	OR TRIBAL GOVERNMENT BOUNDARY OTHER THAN THE ONE IT WAS CAPTURED IN; AND	
15	(IV) WITHIN 24 HOURS OF THE RELOCATION OF A LARGE PREDATOR IF THE RELOCATION SITE HAS BEEN	
16	PREVIOUSLY APPROVED BY THE COMMISSION FOR RELOCATION OF BEARS.	
17	(6) As used in this section:	
18	(a) "consultation" means to actively provide information to a county or tribal government regarding	
19	proposed policy decisions on matters that may have a harmful effect on agricultural production or livestock	
20	operations or that may pose a risk to human health or safety in that county or on those tribal lands and to seek	
21	information and advice from counties or tribal governments on these matters;	
22	(b) "large game species" means deer, elk, mountain sheep, moose, antelope, and mountain goats;	
23	and	
24	(c) "large predators" means bears, mountain lions, and wolves."

26	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Notification to tribal governments. The secretary of state shall send a	
27	copy of [this act] to each federally recognized tribal government in Montana.
