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8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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10	Section 1. Section 69-3-604, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"69-3-604. (Temporary) Standards for determination of rates and conditions. (1) The commission
12	shall determine the rates and conditions of the contract for the sale of electricity by a qualifying small power
13	production facility according to the standards in subsections (2) through (5).
14	(2) Long-term contracts Contracts for the purchase of electricity by the utility from a qualifying small
15	power production facility must be encouraged in order to enhance the economic feasibility of qualifying small
16	power production facilities may be set only for a maximum term of 5 years.
17	(3) The rates to be paid by a utility for electricity purchased from a qualifying small power production
18	facility must be established with consideration of the availability and reliability of the electricity produced.
19	(4) The commission shall set these rates using the avoided cost over the term of the contract.
20	(5) The commission may adopt rules further defining the criteria for qualifying small power production
21	facilities, their cost-effectiveness, and other standards. (Repealed on occurrence of contingencysecs. 1, 3, Ch.

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24	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
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26	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Applicability. [This act] applies to contracts entered into by a utility and
27	a qualifying small power production facility on or after [the effective date of this act].
