4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REQUIRING THE CONSENT OF THE SENATE FOR  
5 APPOINTMENTS TO THE BOARD OF OUTFITTERS; AMENDING SECTION 2-15-1773, MCA; AND  
6 PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 **Section 1.** Section 2-15-1773, MCA, is amended to read:11 **"2-15-1773. Board of outfitters.** (1) There is a board of outfitters.12 (2) The board consists of the following seven members to be appointed by the governor with the consent  
13 of the senate:

14 (a) one big game hunting outfitter;

15 (b) one fishing outfitter;

16 (c) two outfitters who are engaged in the fishing and hunting outfitting business;

17 (d) two sportspersons; and

18 (e) one member of the general public.

19 (3) A favorable vote of at least a majority of all members of the board is required to adopt any resolution,  
20 motion, or other decision.

21 (4) A vacancy on the board must be filled in the same manner as the original appointment.

22 (5) The members shall serve staggered 3-year terms and take office on the day they are appointed.

23 (6) The board is allocated to the department of labor and industry for administrative purposes only as  
24 prescribed in 2-15-121.25 (7) Each member of the board is entitled to receive compensation and travel expenses as provided for  
26 in 37-1-133."
