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8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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10	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Paid leave for domestic violence, sexual assault, or stalking
11	situations. (1) Any employer that offers paid leave, including but not limited to vacation or sick leave, shall
12	include among eligible reasons for leave, if reasons are required, an employee's request for leave to address
13	situations related to being a victim of domestic violence, sexual assault, or stalking.
14	(2) At the employer's discretion:
15	(a) the requested leave may be in addition to the employee's allowable paid leave, but this section does
16	not require additional paid leave; and
17	(b) leave without pay may be provided if an employee has no remaining accrued paid leave.
18	(3) If an employer requires verification of reasons for an employee's request for leave to address a
19	situation related to being a victim of domestic violence, sexual assault, or stalking, the employee may provide any
20	of the documentation provided for in 39-51-2111(2). The employer shall treat any documentation as confidential
21	information.
