4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROTECTING THE PROPERTY RIGHTS OF MONTANA DOG
5	OWNERS BY PROHIBITING COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL GOVERNING BODIES FROM ENACTING OR
6	ENFORCING REGULATIONS THAT ARE SPECIFIC TO A BREED OF DOG."

8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Breed-specific dog regulation prohibited. The governing body of a
11	county may not enact or enforce an ordinance, policy, resolution, or other regulation that is specific as to the
12	breed or perceived breed of a dog, Canis Familiaris. This section does not restrict the authority of the governing
13	body to enact an ordinance as provided in part 1 or this part that applies to all dogs AND DOG HYBRIDS WITH
14	WOLVES, COYOTES, OR JACKALS.
15	
16	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Breed-specific dog regulation prohibited. The governing body of a city
17	or town may not enact or enforce an ordinance, policy, resolution, or other regulation that is specific as to the
18	breed or perceived breed of a dog, Canis Familiaris. This section does not restrict the authority of the governing
19	body to enact an ordinance as provided in part 1 or this part that applies to all dogs AND DOG HYBRIDS WITH
20	WOLVES, COYOTES, OR JACKALS.

22	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Codification instruction. (1) [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
23	integral part of Title 7, chapter 23, part 21, and the provisions of Title 7, chapter 23, part 21, apply to [section 1].
24	(2) [Section 2] is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 7, chapter 23, part 41, and the
25	provisions of Title 7, chapter 23, part 41, apply to [section 2].
