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4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REVISING PUBLIC UTILITY ELECTRICITY COST RECOVERY;
5	CLARIFYING STANDARDIZED TREATMENT OF PUBLIC UTILITIES SUBJECT TO TITLE 69, CHAPTER 3;
6	AMENDING SECTION 69-8-210, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."
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8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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10	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Cost tracking and recovery. (1) The commission shall approve a
11	cost-tracking adjustment for a public utility regulated in accordance with chapter 8 or under this chapter.
12	(2) Cost-tracking adjustments for a public utility must provide for:
13	(a) identical treatment of public utilities subject to chapter 8 or this chapter;
14	(b) 90% shareholder <u>CUSTOMER</u> and 10% customer <u>SHAREHOLDER</u> sharing of costs, if cost sharing is
15	required; and
16	(c) full recovery of costs incurred by a public utility as a result of qualifying small power production facility
17	purchase requirements established in Title 69, chapter 3, part 6.
18	(3) A cost-tracking adjustment may not include a deadband.
19	(4) For the purposes of this section, "deadband" means a level of cost recovery variance, including levels
20	of under-recoveries and over-recoveries to be borne by the public utility.
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22	Section 2. Section 69-8-210, MCA, is amended to read:
23	"69-8-210. Public utilities cost tracking environmentally preferred resources. (1) The
24	commission may shall approve a cost-tracking adjustment for a public utility regulated under this part consistent
25	with its regulation of public utilities under Title 69, chapter 3.
26	(2) Notwithstanding any service options that the commission may require, a public utility shall offer its
27	customers the option of purchasing a product composed of or supporting power from certified environmentally
28	preferred resources that include but are not limited to wind, solar, geothermal, and biomass, subject to review
29	and approval by the commission. The commission shall ensure that these resources have been certified as
30	meeting industry-accepted standards."
