9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Montana fuel economy standards. (1) The board shall set light vehicle
12	fuel economy standards based on either the federal corporate average fuel economy standard or California's
13	low-emission vehicle standard.
14	(2) The board shall select the standard requiring the highest light vehicle fuel economy requirements for
15	average miles per gallon.
16	
17	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Montana fuel economy rulemaking authority. The board shall adopt
18	rules regarding Montana fuel economy standards pursuant to the standards established in [section 1].
19	
20	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Codification instruction. [Sections 1 and 2] are intended to be codified
21	as an integral part of Title 75, chapter 2, part 2, and the provisions of Title 75, chapter 2, part 2, apply to [sections
22	1 and 2].
23	
24	NEW SECTION. Section 4. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
