8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	Section 1. Section 61-5-123, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"61-5-123. Waiver of skills test for veterans with related to military commercial motor vehicles
12	experience rulemaking. (1) The department may waive the skills test required for a commercial driver's license
13	if an applicant who meets the conditions in subsection (2) and is:
14	(a) a veteran of the armed forces of the United States who was honorably discharged;
15	(b) currently serving in the armed forces of the United States;
16	(c) serving full-time in a reserve component, as defined in 37-1-138; or
17	(d) honorably discharged from the reserve component after serving full-time in the reserve component.
18	(2) An applicant shall:
19	(a) certifies certify that, during the 2-year period immediately prior to application, the applicant:
20	(i) did not have more than one license except for a military license;
21	(ii) did not have a license suspended, revoked, or canceled;
22	(iii) was not convicted of a disqualifying offense as provided in 49 CFR 383.51(b);
23	(iv) did not have more than one conviction for a serious traffic violation as provided in 49 CFR 383.51(c);
24	and
25	(v) did not have any conviction for a violation of military, state, or local law relating to motor vehicle traffic
26	control other than a parking violation arising in connection with any traffic accident and has no record of an
27	accident in which the applicant was at fault;
28	(b) provides provide evidence and certifies certify that:
29	(i) the applicant is regularly employed, or within the last 90 days was regularly employed, in a the military
30	position requiring in which the applicant served required regular operation over at least a 2-year period

1	immediately prior to either discharge or application, as applicable, of a commercial motor vehicle representative
2	of the class of motor vehicle for which the applicant is seeking a commercial driver's license; and
3	(ii) the applicant was exempted under 49 CFR 383.3(c) from the requirements of this part when operating
4	a commercial motor vehicle in the military; and
5	(iii) for at least 2 years immediately preceding the applicant's honorable separation from military service
6	as evidenced by the applicant's certificate of release or discharge from active duty, the applicant was operating
7	a motor vehicle representative of the class of motor vehicle for which the applicant is seeking a commercial
8	driver's license .
9	(2)(3) The department shall adopt rules necessary for the administration of this section."
