12	members appointed by the governor in accordance with 2-15-124 and as provided in this section.		
13	(2)	Membership must include but is not limited to:	
14	(a)	one state government law enforcement representative;	
15	(b)	one chief of police, who may be appointed based on recommendations from the Montana	
16	association of chiefs of police;		
17	(c)	one sheriff, who may be appointed based on recommendations from the Montana sheriffs and	
18	peace officers association;		
19	(d)	one representative from the department of corrections established in 2-15-2301;	
20	(e)	one local law enforcement officer in a nonadministrative position, who may be appointed based	
21	on recommendations from the Montana police protective association;		
22	(f)	one detention center administrator or detention officer;	
23	(g)	one Montana-certified tribal law enforcement representative;	
24	(h)	one county attorney, who may be appointed based on recommendations from the Montana	
25	county attorneys association;		
26	(i)	two members of the board of crime control established in 2-15-2008;	
27	<u>(j)</u>	one misdemeanor probation officer, as defined in 46-23-1001, who is certified by the Montana	
28	public safety of	ficer standards and training council AND WHO MAY BE APPOINTED BASED ON RECOMMENDATIONS
