1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2 STATE OF MONTANA:

That the Montana Legislature recognize the dedication, professionalism, and bravery of all Montanans who have served and will serve in the armed forces of the United States as part of the global war on terror.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State send copies of this resolution to the Montana Congressional Delegation, the respective Secretaries of the United States Army, Navy, and Air Force, the Commandant of the United States Marine Corps, the Commandant of the United States Coast Guard, and the Adjutant General of the Montana National Guard.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State; in coordination with the Montana Department of Military Affairs, be encouraged to promote this resolution by encouraging the family members and friends of Montana's active duty military service members to contact the Department with the names and mailing addresses of the services members so that the Department may send a copy of this resolution to each Montana service member: INCLUDE WITH THE COPIES SENT TO THE RESPECTIVE SECRETARIES OF THE ARMY, NAVY, AND AIR FORCE, THE COMMANDANT OF THE UNITED STATES MARINE CORPS, THE COMMANDANT OF THE UNITED STATES COAST GUARD, AND THE ADJUTANT GENERAL OF THE MONTANA NATIONAL GUARD A REQUEST THAT THE RESPECTIVE SECRETARIES AND COMMANDANTS AND THE ADJUTANT GENERAL USE EVERY MEANS AVAILABLE TO PROVIDE A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO EACH MEMBER OF THE ARMED FORCES WHO HAILS FROM MONTANA.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the purpose and intent of this resolution is to convey to Montana service personnel that the heartfelt thanks of all Montanans are extended to them, that we are proud of them, that they are in our prayers, and that we send them best wishes for a safe return.
