OVERVIEW: *House Bill 101 would designate Haywood County as the official elk capital of the State of North Carolina.*

CURRENT LAW: State symbols and other official adoptions of the State are found in Chapter 145 of the General Statutes. Currently, North Carolina does not have an official elk capital.

BILL ANALYSIS: House Bill 101 would amend Chapter 145 of the General Statutes by adding a new section to designate Haywood County as the official elk capital of the State of North Carolina.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act is effective when it becomes law.
