

## HOUSE BILL 196: 2021 COVID-19 Response & Relief, Sec. 2.7: Compliance/Occupancy to Health Service Facilities

OVERVIEW: Section 2.7 of S.L. 2021-3 directs local governments to issue a temporary certificate of compliance and a temporary certificate of occupancy to allow for the full operational use of a health care facility under the following circumstances:

- The facility is currently under construction and the scheduled completion date for the building will occur before the recission of Executive Order No. 116.
- The facility may be safely occupied and complies with the building permit and all applicable State and local laws.
- The only portions of the project that remain to be completed are off-site improvements to public roadways which are required as conditions for the approval of the permit and the facility agrees to: (i) complete the roadway improvements within 18 months of the date of the certificate of occupancy and (ii) post a performance bond or letter of credit.

This section became effective March 11, 2021, and expires upon the recission of Executive Order No. 116 or upon completion of the roadway improvements, whichever is later.
