,	SECTION 1.(a) Section 3.5 of S.L. 2015-35, as amended by Section 30 of S.L.			
	2015-264, reads as rewritten:			
	"SECTION 3.5.(a) Notwithstanding the PLAN OF MERGER OF THE IREDELL			
	COUNTY AND STATESVILLE CITY SCHOOLS, as amended by Section 2 of S.L. 2002-18,

"SECTION 3.5.(b) For positions elected on a nonpartisan basis in 2012 or 2014, beginning
 in 2022, vacancies occurring in the membership of the Iredell-Statesville Schools Board of
 Education shall be filled for the unexpired term by the remaining members of the Board of
 Education."

SECTION 1.(b) This act does not affect the terms of office of any person elected in 27 2018 or 2020 to the Iredell-Statesville Schools Board of Education. Each member of the 28 Iredell-Statesville Schools Board of Education elected in 2018 and 2020, or any member 29 appointed to fill a vacancy for a member elected in 2018 or 2020, shall serve until a successor 30 has been elected and qualified.

31 SECTION 2. Effective the first Monday in December of 2022, G.S. 115C-37.1(d)
 32 reads as rewritten:

"(d) This section shall apply only in the following counties: Alleghany, Beaufort,
Brunswick, Carteret, Cherokee, Clay, Cleveland, Dare, Davie, Graham, Guilford, Harnett, Hyde,



Iredell, Lee, Madison, New Hanover, Onslow, Pender, Rutherford, Stanly, Stokes, Surry, Vance, 1 2 Washington, and Yancey." 3 **SECTION 3.** Sections 1 and 2 of this act become effective only if approved by a 4 majority of the qualified voters of the Iredell-Statesville Schools Administrative Unit in a 5 referendum. The election shall be conducted by the Iredell County Board of Elections on 6 November 3, 2020. The question on the ballot shall be: 7 "[] FOR [] AGAINST 8 Changing the election method of the Iredell-Statesville Schools Board of Education 9 from partisan to nonpartisan." 10 **SECTION 4.** Sections 1 and 2 of this act become effective upon ratification of the
