## SESSION LAW 2020-21 HOUSE BILL 1157

AN ACT ABOLISHING THE OFFICE OF CORONER IN AVERY, BLADEN, HOKE, AND MONTGOMERY COUNTIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.(a)** The office of coroner in Montgomery County is abolished.

**SECTION 1.(b)** Chapter 152 of the General Statutes is not applicable to Montgomery County.

**SECTION 2.(a)** The office of coroner is abolished.

**SECTION 2.(b)** Chapter 152 of the General Statutes is not applicable.

**SECTION 2.(c)** This section applies only in the following counties: Avery, Bladen, and Hoke Counties.

**SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding Section 2 of this act, any coroner elected in the 2018 or 2020 general election shall serve the remainder of their term. If a vacancy occurs in the office of coroner, a person may be appointed to serve the remainder of the unexpired term.

**SECTION 4.** Sections 2 and 3 of this act become effective January 1, 2021. The remainder of this act is effective when it becomes law.
